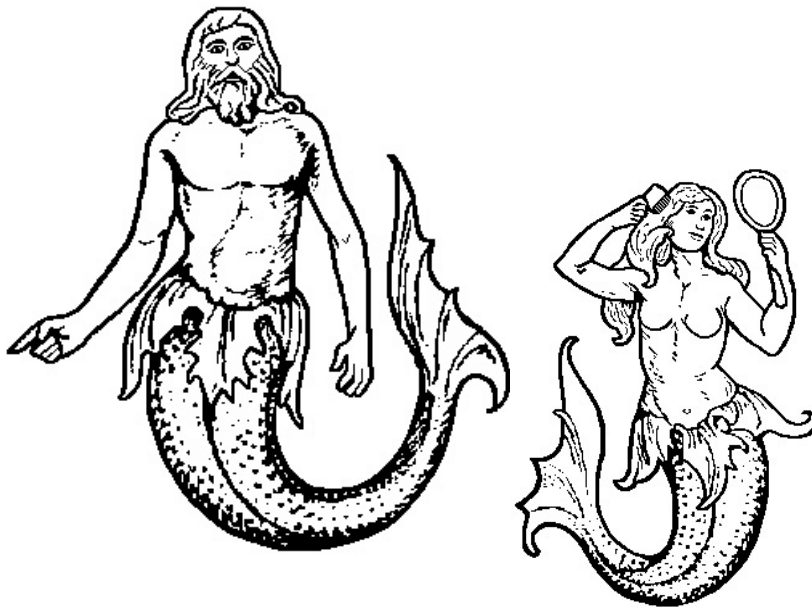






From the Herald and Chirurgeon...

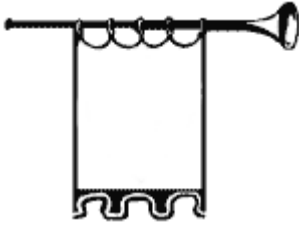


Greetings unto the populace of Seawinds!

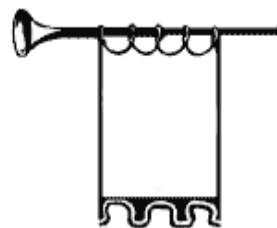

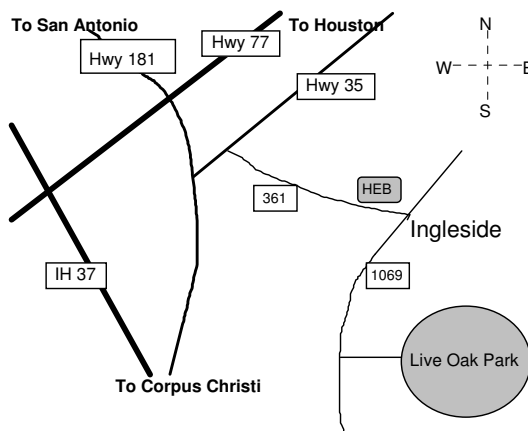

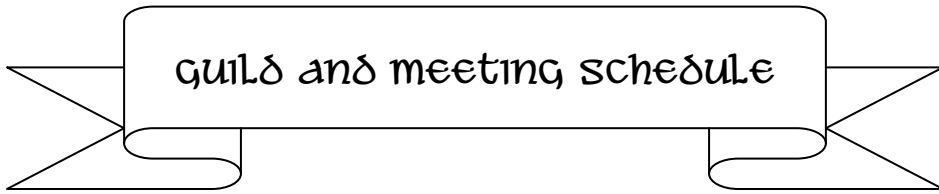
